

BEANIS WEENIE CASEROLE

From the Kitchen of Smiley T McButterpants

Ingredients:

- · 2 tbsp olive oil • 1 medium yellow onion, finely diced
- · 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 12 oz smoked sausage or kielbasa, sliced into 1/4-inch rounds 2 cups cooked white beans (e.g., cannellini or navy beans)
- 1 cup cooked black beans
- 1 cup tomato passata (pureed tomatoes)
- 1/2 cup barbecue sauce (use a smoky, rich variety) • 1/2 cup chicken or vegetable stock

 Topping:
- 1 tbsp Dijon mustard • 2 cups panko breadcrumbs
- 1 tsp smoked paprika
- 1 tsp fresh thyme leaves
- 1/2 tsp cayenne pepper (optional)

 1/2 tsp cayenne pepper (optional)

 2 tbsp butter, melted
- 1/2 tsp black pepper
- 1 tbsp parsley, finely chopped · Salt to taste

• 1/2 cup grated Parmesan

- 1. Preheat Oven: Preheat your oven to 375°F (190°C).
- 2. Sauté the Base: Heat olive oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add the onions and garlic, cooking until soft and fragrant (about 3 minutes). Add the sausage slices and cook until browned. 3. Build the Sauce: Stir in the beans, tomato passta, barbecue sauce,
- stock, Dijon mustard, and seasonings. Simmer for 5-7 minutes, allowing the flavors to meld. Adjust seasoning with salt as needed. 4. Assemble the Casserole: Transfer the mixture to a greased casserole
- 5. Prepare the Topping:Spread evenly over bean and sausage mixture.
 6. Bake: Bake for 20-25 minutes, or until golden and crispy. 7. Serve: Let rest for 5 minutes before serving. Garnish with additional

Imperial Happenings






Brews Brothers



A newly arrived bar top installation is underway at Camp Alzafar's pavilion, incorporating materials salvaged and donated by Kyle Jackson, including pecky cypress salvaged from the river bottom at camp Alzafar by Kyle during the 2016 river cleanup and oak from Kyle's Boerne property. The pecky cypress and oak began its journey to Houston in 2023 where Allen Grotzinger used his expertise in carpentry skills and his vision of what the raw lumber would become. Miguel Arizona, owner of Arizola Carpentry, graciously shared his work shop, and so the task of building the 19 foot bar top began. You can think of the pecky cypress as a giant sponge full of holes. Stabilizing the pecky cypress required extensive labor and over 5 gallons of epoxy. Oak components were carefully milled, cut, and sanded for what was to become the drink and bar rail. As the vision came to life the so did the bar top. Applying the finish took more than 11/2 gallons of polyurethane with 15 plus coats, sanding and repeating until a mirror like finish was obtained. Allen Grotzinger donated the funding for additional materials and over 300 hours of labor in support of Shriners Children's philanthropy. We look forward to the completion of the bar as we continue to finish this project.
